“The course is in very good condition and with warmer weather on the way we expect to see a lot more green in the coming months.” Justin Curren advised WNN.

“You can also expect to see continued activity from sand trap maintenance. Greens aeration will continue. The sprinkler system is a constant challenge.”

“Our financial position is very good as we head into the spring and summer months. We finished the first quarter of 2011, \$4,624.00 under budget.” Justin further stated, “While this looks good, I can assure you that the hot weather demands on water and electricity will challenge us financially in the near term.”

One example of money saving factors was the way the group was able to generate a maintenance surplus during the first quarter. The volunteers repaired sprinklers on holes #4, 9, 15, 16 and 17 for only \$947.00.

It is estimated that the group saved \$1,400.00 in outside labor expenses. Justin praised the team of Mike Prine, Bill Miller, Gary Nelson, John Channing and Willie Wiginton for their hard work. Justin said, “You can readily see that it is manpower and financial contributions that allow us to keep afloat.”

The bulkhead work on hole #14 is almost finished. It will take a while for the grass to grow back in the construction area. This work will protect this beautiful hole for years to come.

There is a 9 hole mixed scramble held every other Sunday afternoon. This event is under the direction of Mike Prine. The first two “scrambles” were well attended and enjoyed by those participants.

Justin says, “We thank everyone for their continued financial support and ask that you keep the money coming as we hit the high expense
